

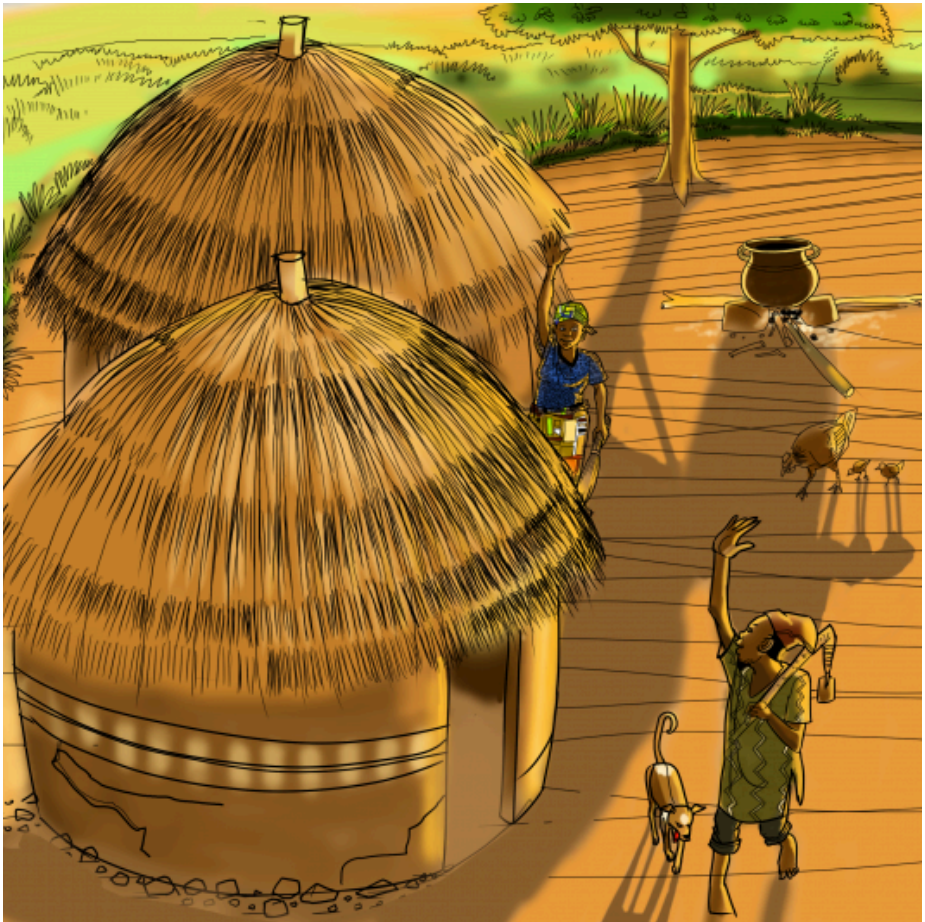


Ndzi ta xi kuma
