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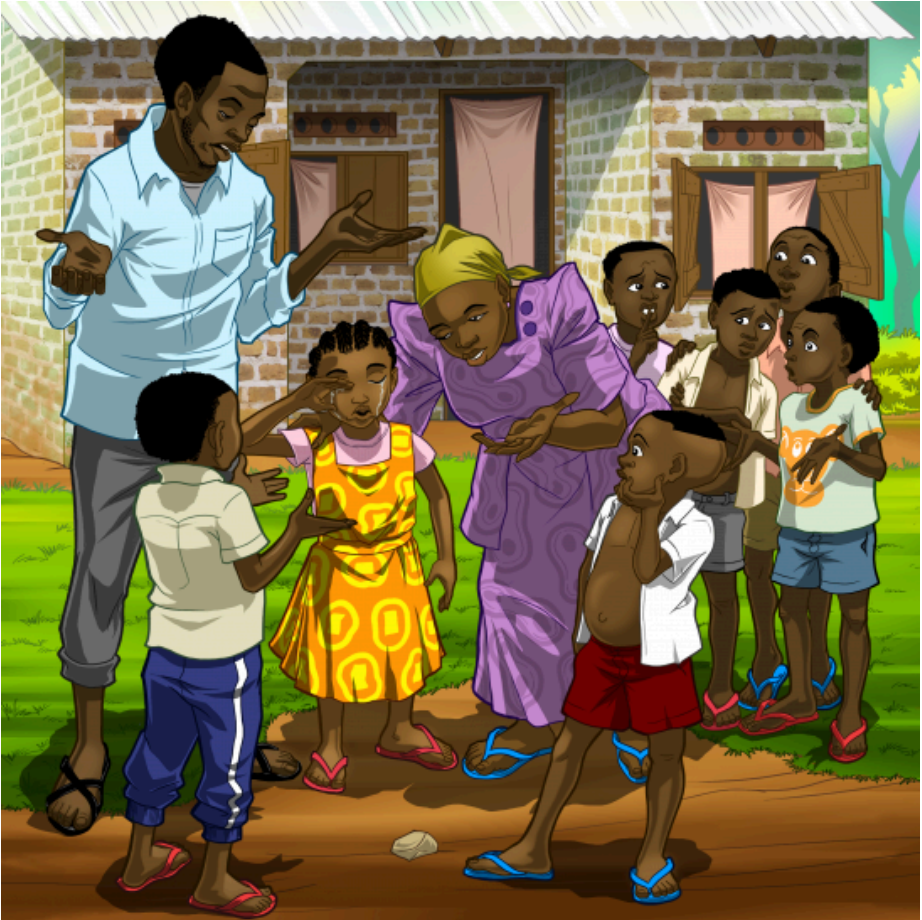




UKhathaza wayethandwa kakhulu ekhaya.

Waze waqala ukucula naye.

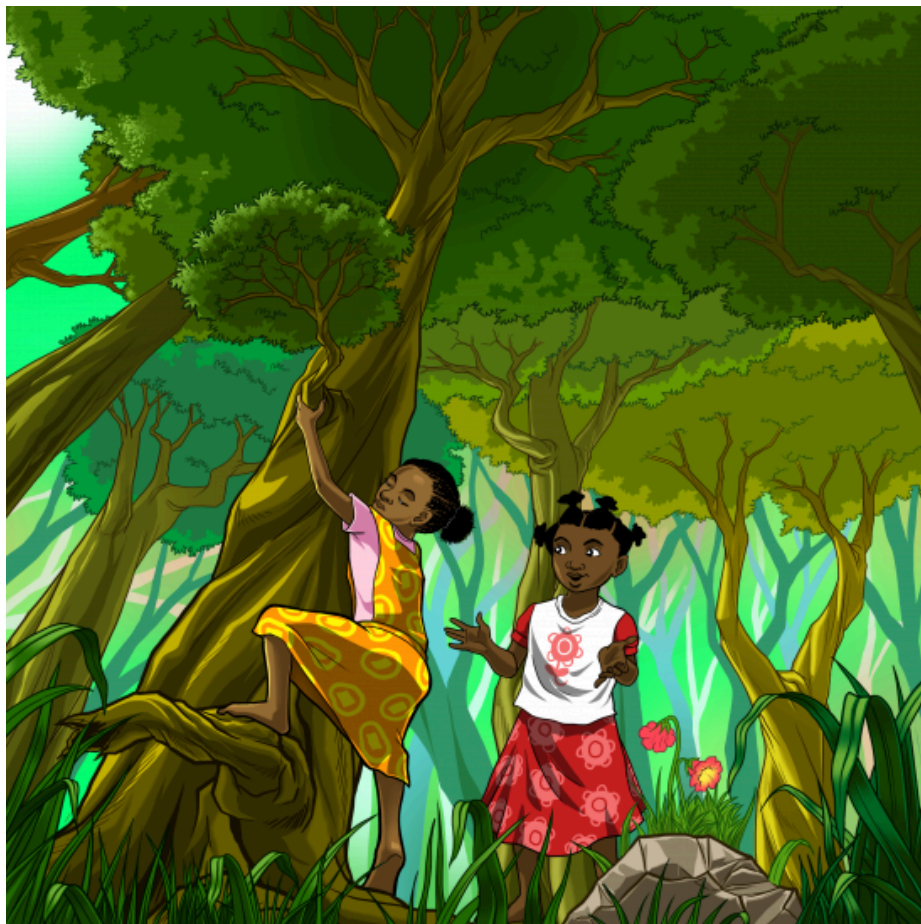
Naphezu kwalokhu wayengakafuni ukwehla emthini.
